Message from Mitch Yeaton – Founder and Chief Executive Officer – White Horse Addiction Center, Inc.

It has been a pleasure to have retired early from United Parcel Service (UPS) after 34 years of service to come back to my home state of New Hampshire. I spent many years as a Global Director and on the Board of Directors of No Longer Bound, a non-profit men's residential program in Georgia. When I heard about the opioid epidemic here in NH, I knew it was time to come home and be of service. It took two years to gain county and local approvals, become incorporated, and obtain our 501(c)(3) status. In the past year, we have been blessed to add many dedicated employees and volunteers to our agency. We started with a cottage industry, our Thrift Store, to help support the addiction services and since have increased outpatient services to include Individual Therapy, Intensive Outpatient Programs and Licensed Alcohol and Drug Counselors. We have two Recovery Community Organizations now in Center Ossipee ("The Shed") and in N. Conway ("Shed North"), New Hampshire.

"Overdoses have come down since White Horse Addiction Center started adding services. We were seeing 5-6 overdoses a week, now we only see 1-2 a month." --- Chief Eldridge, Ossipee, NH Police Department.
